

CYCLEBALL

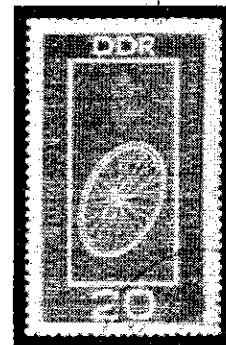

Stamps:

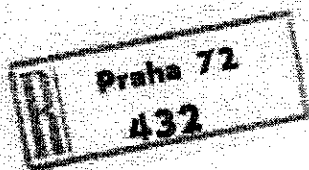
There is another stamp commemorating the Indoor cycling. It is the GERMANY EAST stamp issued 29.07.1969 to commemorate the Indoor World Cycling Championship in Eastern Germany. In spite, of cycleball not being depicted directly, it must be added to the list of cycleball stamps to make it complete.



Special cancellations:

Germany 1959 - special cancellation used to commemorate the Indoor World Cycling Championship in Stuttgart.

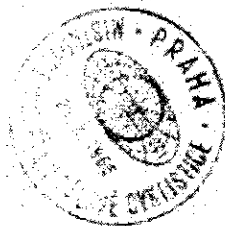
Czechoslovakia 1965 - special cancellation used to commemorate the Indoor World Cycling Championship in Prague. ↓

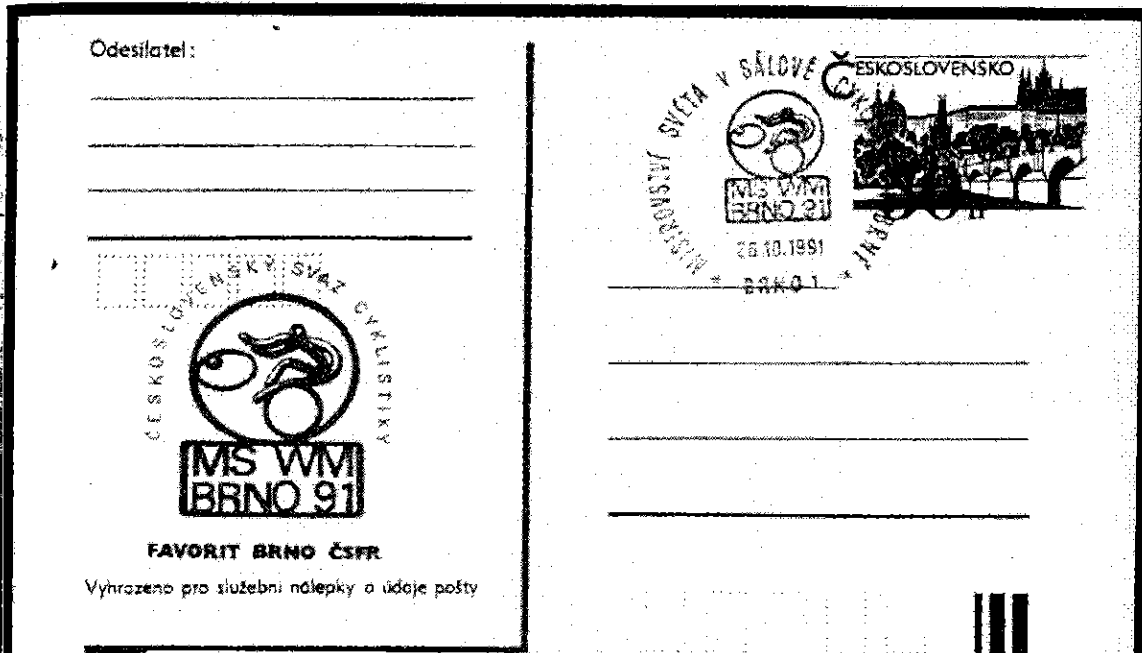

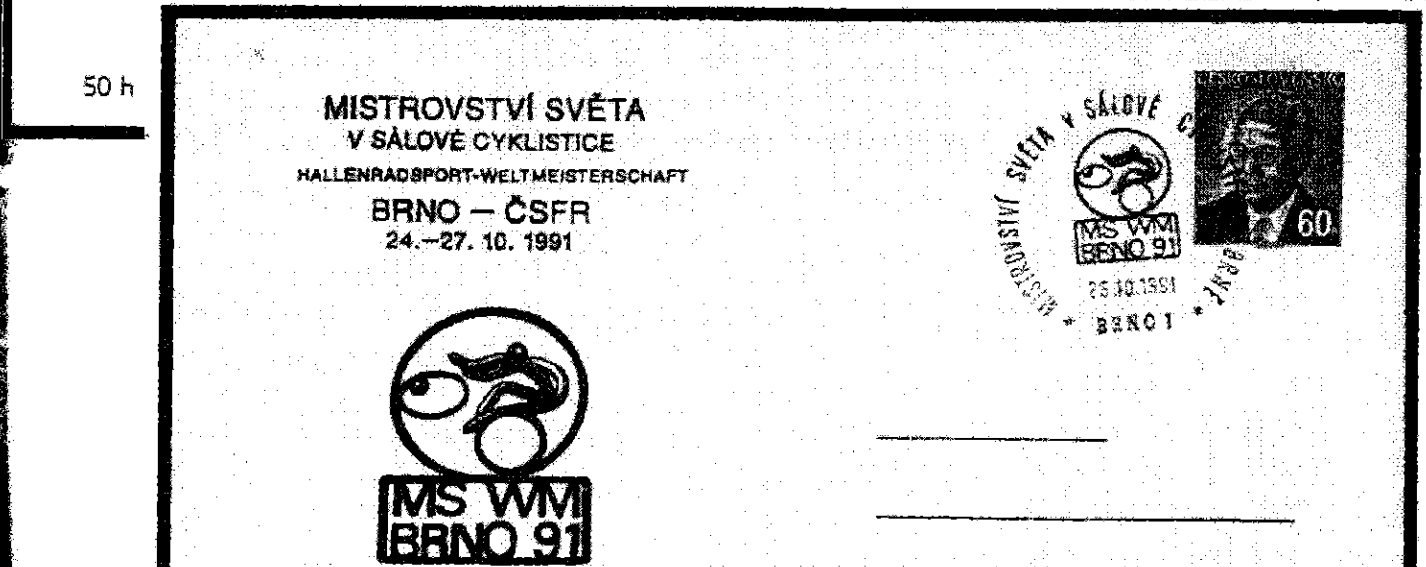
Unofficial imprints (prints made on official postcards and postal stationary privately)

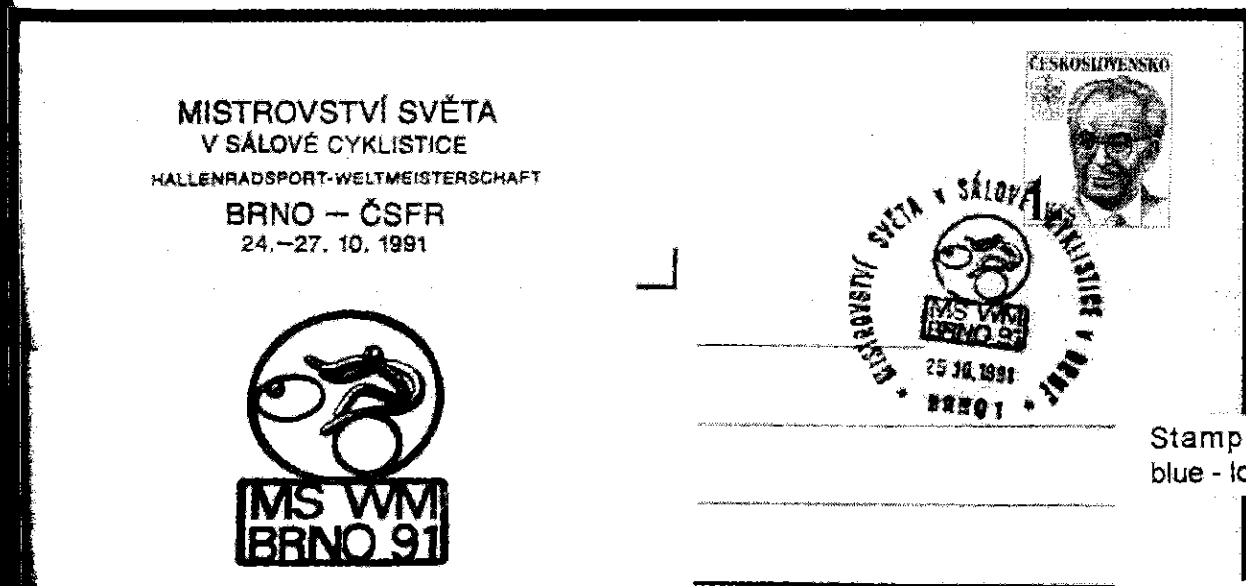


Stamp imprint purple - with logo both red or blue

Stamp imprint red - logo blue



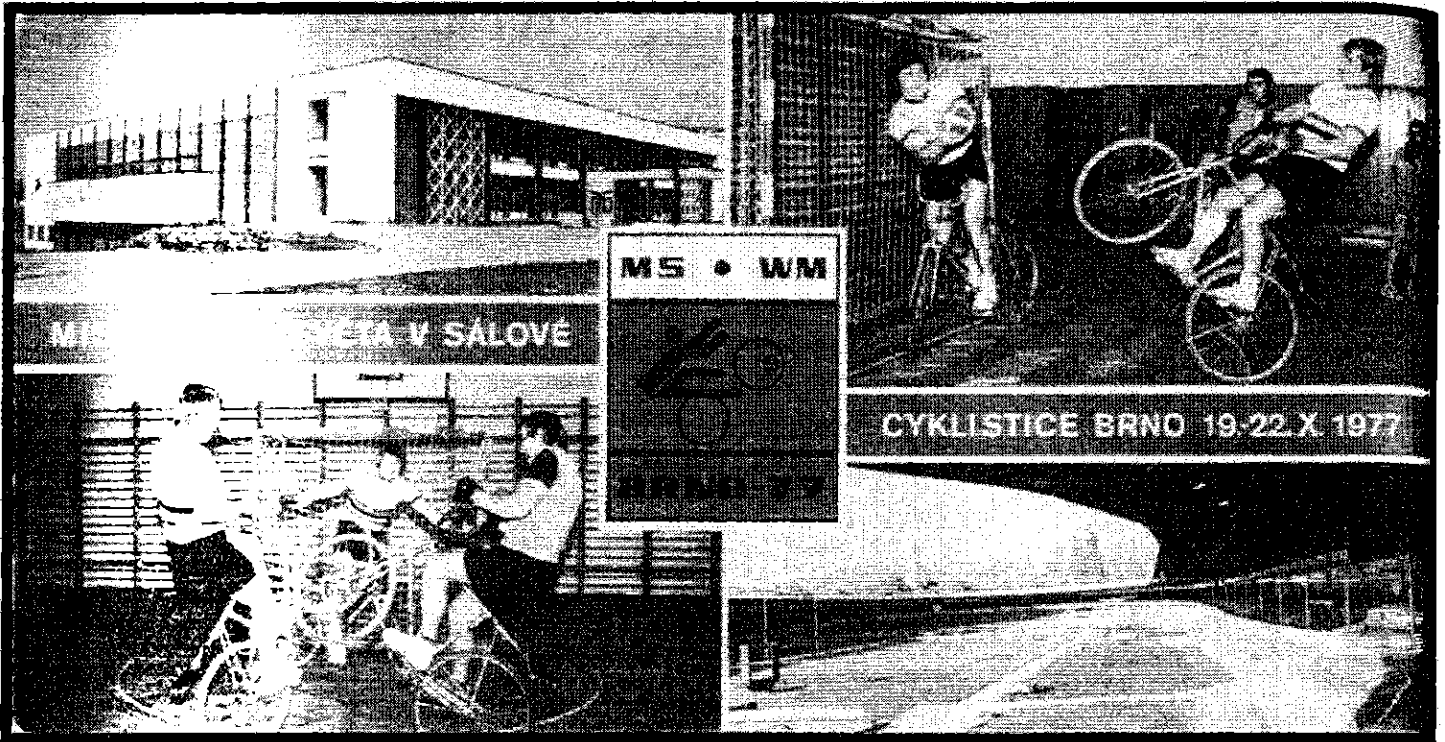

Postcard:

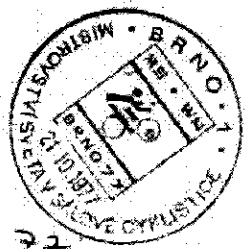
Czechoslovakia 1977 - colour postcard issued to commemorate the Indoor World Cycling Championship in Brno and the training hall of the famous indoor cycleball players Jan and Jindrich Pospíšil. The address side is illustrated with the special cancellation and with signatures of Japanese participants, probably cycleball players.

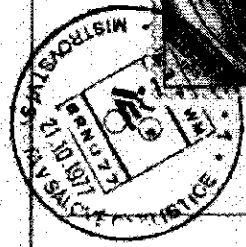
